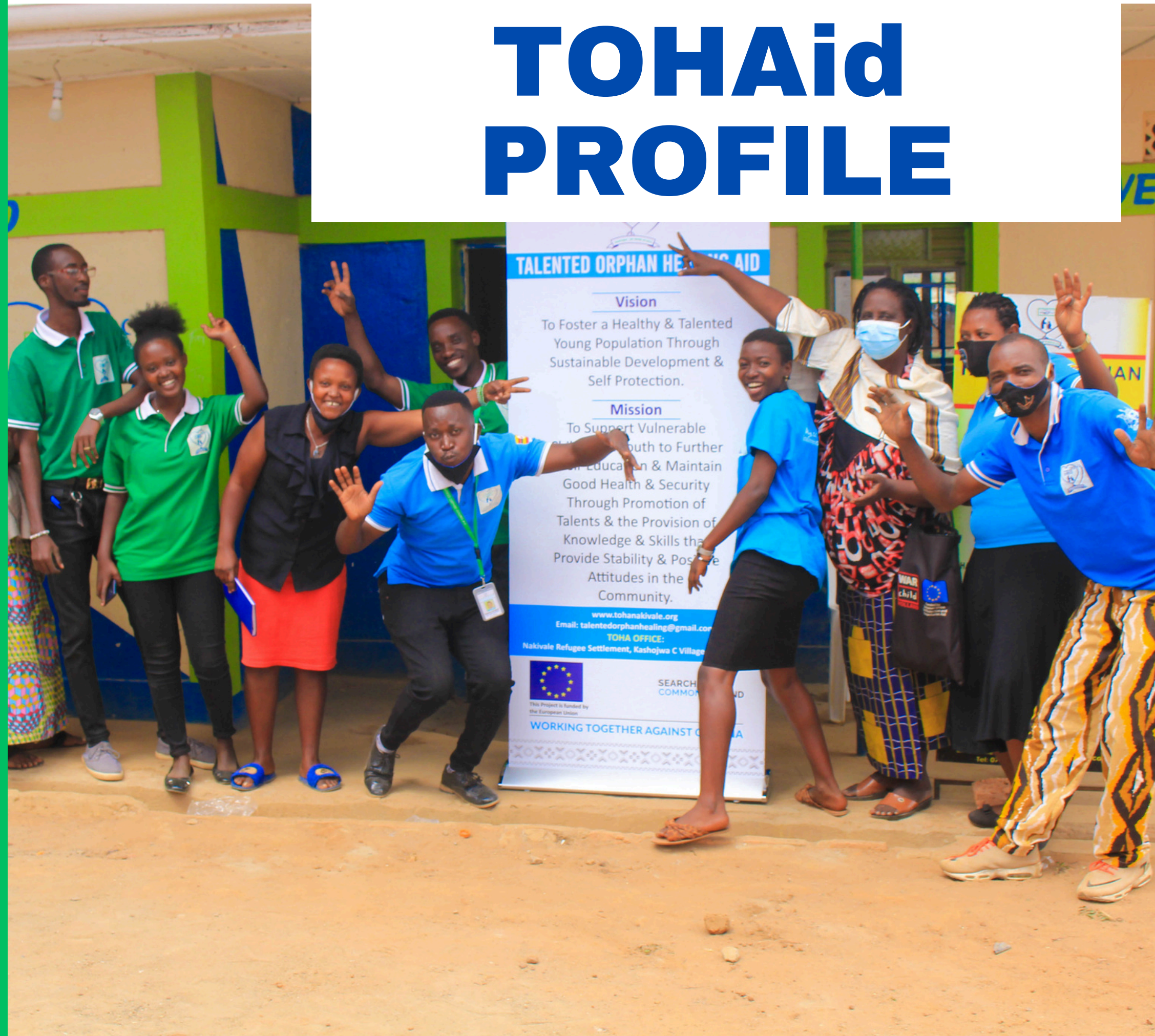

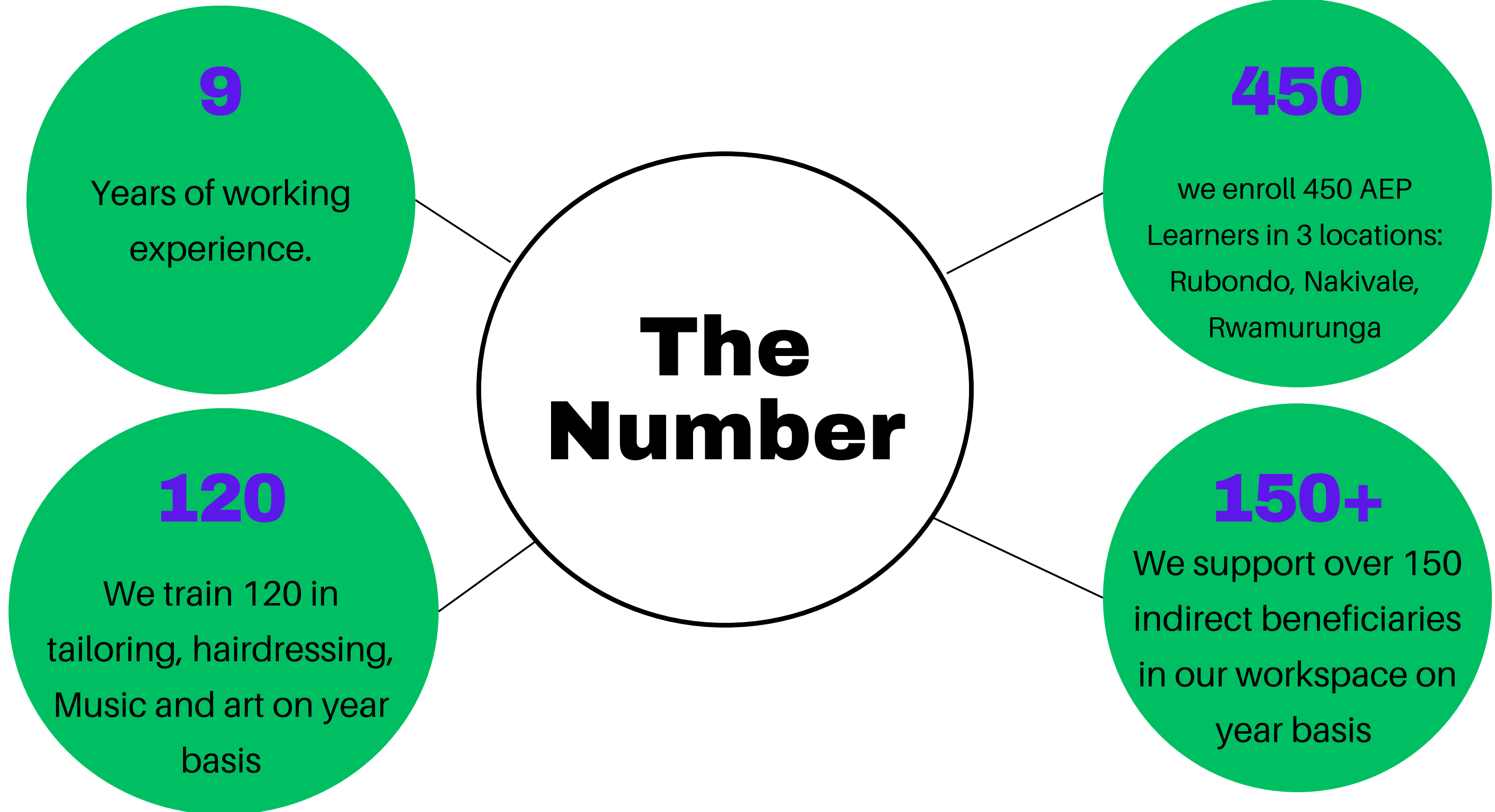


ABOUT US

Talented Orphan Healing Aid (TOHAid) is a refugee-led, non-profit organization based in Nakivale Refugee Settlement, Uganda. Established in 2015, TOHAid supports vulnerable children and youth facing educational, health, and security challenges in the refugee context. We empower adolescents by equipping them with handcraft skills, entrepreneurship skills, leadership skills and fostering positive community attitudes to enhance their future prospects.

In partnership with War Child Canada, TOHAid is implementing the Bridge Project, which aims to improve access to quality education and employment opportunities for refugee and host community youth in Uganda. This initiative focuses on bridging the gap from secondary education and skills development to job opportunities, ultimately enhancing the prospects for these young individuals.

Benefice has certifications in Information Technology and leadership, and has worked with Finnish Refugee Council, OPM, UNHCR, UNICEF, and others. He co-founded the Association of Community-Based Organizations in Nakivale and Association Inkerebutsi for Development in Burundi. Recognized as a Top 30 under 30 changemaker by OD Impact Challenge 2023 and a YALI alumnus, Benefice has over nine years of experience in community development, focusing on education, livelihood, child protection, health, and environmental initiatives.

Our Services

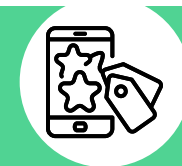
LEADERSHIP

TOHAid trains youth refugees in leadership skills to help them effectively manage and launch their small enterprises and initiatives.



ENTREPRENEURSHIP

TOHAid provides entrepreneurship training to youth refugees, equipping them with essential skills to start and sustain their own businesses, fostering self-reliance and resilience.



BRIDGE PROJECT AEP

TOHAid, War Child Canada, and Mastercard Foundation's BRIDGE Project (2022-2026) tackles youth unemployment in Ugandan refugee settlements, enhancing education access for displaced youth in partnership with stakeholders.



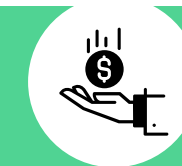
VOCATIONAL TRAINING CENTER

TOHAid's Girls Empowerment in Action (GEA) program offers vocational training in tailoring, handcrafting, and hairdressing to empower marginalized adolescent girls and improve their community integration.



ENGLISH & LIBRARY

TOHAid's library, supporting Smile English School, offers 650 English books, from children's stories to literary classics and nonfiction, for all TOHA beneficiaries to enhance classroom learning.
